

PRIVACY POLICY

Pursuant to art. 13 of European Regulation 679/2016

c) Purpose and legal basis of processing

Your data will be processed in order to ensure performance of the contract existing between yourself and ourselves and to comply with the obligations arising from the law.

d) Persons to whom data may be communicated

In order to be permit the performance of the agreed service, your data may be communicated to (among others) accounting or tax advisors; banking, credit or insurance institutions; and transport companies. Only such data strictly necessary for the performance of the requested service will be communicated and, where possible, anonymous processing methods will be preferred.

Your data will not be disclosed in any way to third parties without your prior and specific consent.

e) Data transfer to third countries or international organisations

Your data will in no way be transferred to third countries outside the EU.

f) Retention period for personal data

Your personal data will be kept for as long as is strictly necessary to perform the agreed contractual service in accordance with any other civil or tax law regulations that may require further retention periods.

g) Rights of data subjects

You have at all times the right to request access to your data from the Data Controller, as well as to request the correction or deletion of said data.

You will receive a written reply within 30 days (unless you specifically request a verbal reply), which may also be in electronic format. You also have the right to request the limitation of processing or to object to processing. Finally, you may request the portability of your data to another Data Controller.

You may also at any time revoke the consent provided by means of this notice. In order to revoke one or more of the elements of consent provided, simply contact one of the addresses indicated at points a) or b) above.

h) Right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority

If you believe your data have been processed unlawfully you have the right to contact the Supervisory Authority in order to lodge a complaint.

i) Automated decision-making processes

The Data Controller does not any use automated decision-making processes in respect of your personal data.
